NMT and PT work together to create these designs and configurations to best meet the needs of each individual and their motor rehabilitation. NMT "is also useful for helping one overcome unhealthy compensation strategies while increasing strength, endurance and motor control" (Mertel, Chapter 10 NMT Handbook).
